Course / Amenities

The three mile course highlights the wetness and hilliness of the Severance wilderness. The trails are largely wide and open; however, the footing ranges from hard packed gravel to logging roads to rocky, ankle-twisting ground. Sections of it are always wet (some are very wet) and the course may be snow-covered, so caution is advised. (Snowshoe entrants are always welcome.)

In previous races the temperature has ranged from 15 degrees to 60, and the weather from sunny to snowy. Water will be available at the finish as will a fire to huddle around if the weather is cold.

Thanksgiving is a big hunting day and the race course runs into the woods well away from roads and populated areas. **Wearing red, orange, or other "don't shoot me" colors is required.**
